

## **DRESS CODE**

We believe the appearance of students to be of sufficient importance to require specific standards of dress, which must be maintained while students are at school and at school sponsored activities away from school

### **GIRLS**

- Plain white short-sleeved shirt is to be worn tucked in at the waistband. Long sleeved turtlenecks may be worn in the winter months.
- Students in grades K-4 will wear the plaid SJS uniform jumper.
- Students in grades 5-8 will wear the plaid SJS uniform skirt.
- Knee socks or crew socks that are 3-4” above the ankle are to be white or navy blue. No peds, tennis socks, or anklet socks are allowed.
- Skirts and jumpers must be within 4 inches of the knee and provide modest coverage.
- Girls may not wear sweat pants with their skirts.
- Students may also wear navy blue twill shorts or slacks. No outside patch or “cargo” pockets. Dark solid belts must be worn with and belt loops may not be removed from pants or shorts.
- Undergarments should not be visible through school blouses.

### **BOYS**

- Plain white short-sleeved collared shirt is to be worn tucked in at the waistband. Long sleeved turtlenecks may be worn in the winter months.
- Students may also wear navy blue twill shorts or slacks. No outside patch or “cargo” pockets. Dark solid belts must be worn with and belt loops may not be removed from pants or shorts.
- Crew socks that are 3-4” above the ankle are to be white, forest green or navy blue. No peds, tennis socks, or anklet socks are allowed.
- Tee shirts worn under uniform shirts must be white – no Logos or messages.

### **BOYS AND GIRLS**

- Students must possess either a sweater vest with the schools logo or a sweatshirt with the school logo.
- Headgear and outerwear are to be worn only out-of-doors and only during inclement weather.
- Dark glasses may not be worn unless prescribed by a physician with a note on file in the school office. No cosmetic contacts allowed.

- All students must be in compliance with the school uniform policy while in the classroom and in the Church.

## **SHOES**

- Black, white, navy blue, or brown shoes with a non-marking sole. No roller shoes, lights, cartoon characters.
- Shoes must be fastened tightly at all times. Shoelaces must be white or the same color as the shoe.
- No boots.

## **PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORMS**

- Physical Education uniforms are required and are available for purchase from True Grits. Students must wear a PE Tee shirt and navy blue SJS sweatpants or shorts. Shorts must be mid thigh in length. Students may come to school in PE uniform on prescribed PE days only. If there is a scheduled school activity, then students will come in regular uniform and may change for PE.

## **GROOMING**

It is expected that students will be neatly groomed and attired at all times, during school and school sponsored events. Habits of cleanliness and hygiene must be fostered at home as well as at school. Clothing must be neat and clean in appearance with no rips, safety pins, and no baggy pants. All rules regarding jewelry, hair, make-up pertaining to school and any extra-curricular events; sport events, academic competitions, etc. should be observed.

## **JEWELRY**

Girls may wear a single pair of stud earrings only. No other type of earrings is permitted, Religious medals may be worn only if kept under uniform shirt. Temporary or permanent body tattoos are not allowed. Boys may not wear any type of earrings. Body piercing other than ears is not allowed.

## **MAKE-UP**

Perfumes, perfumed lotions, nail polish, colored lip gloss, or any type of make-up product, including glitters are not permitted.
